The International Society of Animal Genetics (ISAG) is devoted to the study of the immunogenetics, molecular genetics and functional genomics of economically important and domesticated animal species. ISAG supports the efficient exchange of research ideas, results and applications primarily by arranging conferences and workshops, by organising comparison tests, and by publishing the official journal of the Society (*Animal Genetics*).

The 2012 ISAG conference will include an exciting blend of related plenary sessions and workshops of interest to animal geneticists and scientists from around the world. The theme of the ISAG 2012 conference is "Quantitative Genetics Meets Molecular Genetics" and many of our plenary speakers will reflect this theme. However, the plenary sessions will reflect also a wide variety of other interesting and topical areas in genetics and molecular biology.



Profile of Attendees

The biennial conference of the International Society for Animal Genetics (ISAG) provides an international forum for researchers working within the fields of immunogenetics, biochemical genetics and molecular genetics. For over twenty years, ISAG members have been at the forefront of the application of genomics approaches for genetics research in farmed and companion animals. The conference will provide an opportunity for delegates to explore the latest advances and view the newest technologies in the field of animal genetics, as well as offering our industry partners the opportunity to introduce themselves and their products to a high calibre audience, and discuss future developments.

At least 600 participants are expected to attend ISAG 2012. The previous event, which was held in Edinburgh in 2010, attracted similar numbers and the very strong scientific program combined with the attractiveness of Cairns as a venue, leads us to be confident of an excellent attendance at this conference as well. We are expecting a large contingent particularly from Asia, as China will host the next conference. We estimate that over 50% of the delegates will be from Australia, New Zealand and Asia. The remainder will be mainly from the USA and Europe, but with strong representation from South America. Approximately half of the delegates will be principal investigators and half will be post-graduate students, post-doctoral researcher fellows and others.

- 3. To give delegates the opportunity to network with colleagues
- 4. To organise a conference that is accessible to young scientists

• Plenary speakers (\$5,500) (included in Platinum sponsor package)

Subject to the agreement of the Scientific Programme Committee and the speaker, all of the plenary speakers are available for sponsorship. While companies will have no control over the content of the speaker presentation, they will be acknowledged as sponsors by having their company logo slide at the beginning and end of the presentation and on the announcement slides outside the room. (Note: Plenary speakers may be sponsored by Gold sponsors instead of holding a lunchtime satellite symposium or workshop.)

• Lunchtime satellite symposium or workshop (\$5,500) (included in Platinum and Gold sponsor packages)

Sponsors will have the opportunity to hold a satellite symposium or workshop at lunchtime on Monday 16, Tuesday 17, or Thursday 19 July. The session will be of one hour's duration and will take place in the Main Hall, with seating for all delegates. Dates will be allocated on a "first come, first served" basis.
