Summary of the meeting including votes, decisions taken and plans for future conferences

The Committee chair (E. Giuffra) organized the workshop in collaboration with the three standing committee members (J-H. Lee, K. Schachtschneider, and R. Pena). While preparing for the workshop, it was decided that the 'younger' members (K. Schachtschneider and R. Pena) would take the role of organizers and lead this workshop session. This was communicated to participants by E. Giuffra in introducing the workshop session. Two of the talks planned in agenda (see below) were not presented, as the presenters were unable to obtain visas to attend the meeting.

Elections: Given the shortened time frame between the 2016 and 2017 conferences, the members of the workshop voted to retain the 2 standing committee members who had completed their 4-year terms (E. Giuffra and J-H. Lee) for an additional 1-year term. New standing committee members to replace E. Giuffra and J-H. Lee will be elected at the 2017 conference. In addition, R. Pena and K. Schachtschneider were appointed as the new co-chairs of the standing committee. All the current members of the standing committee will work with the co-chairs to organize the workshop for the ISAG 2017 conference, based on selection of submitted abstracts. The members are also encouraged to identify standing committee member candidates, and propose speakers to the organizers of the next ISAG conference.
